- **Inter-College and Inter-University Elocution Competition**  
The elocution competition for XV Agricultural Science Congress 2021 was organized by Directorate of Students' Welfare, RPCAU Pusa on 25<sup>th</sup> Oct and 27<sup>th</sup> Oct 2021 at the Panchatantra Hall. The topic of Elocution competition was "Optimization of energy for sustainable agriculture." Dr. S Roy Chowdhary, Dean CBSH, Dr. B Kumar, Scholar in Residence and Dr. Ranjan Laik were the esteemed judges. The winner of inter college elocution was Ms. Megha from CoF and runner-up was Ms. Aleena Antony from CoF, Dholi. The inter-university competition was held on 27<sup>th</sup> Oct, 2021 under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Vice Chancellor as a zonal coordinator for Zone IV. Students from 12 universities participated in this event. The winner was Mr. Soham Shao from OUAT, Bhubneshwar, second position was bagged by Mr. Raunak Singh from BAU, Kanke, Ranchi, and the third and fourth position were bagged by RPCAU, Pusa. The first two winners got nominated for XV Agricultural Congress to be held from 13-16<sup>th</sup> Nov at BHU, Varanasi.
- **CAE Pusa Alumni Association Organized Lecture Series**  
CAE Pusa Alumni association organized 9<sup>th</sup> lecture series of CAE Alumni, Er. Vikas Jha, Group Head – Trade & Supply chain, business, Emirates national bank of Dubai CAE batch 1996 on 29<sup>th</sup> October 2021. ## Research Activities

- **11<sup>th</sup> Research Council Meeting (Rabi) organized**  
The 11<sup>th</sup> Research Council Meeting, Rabi-2021 of the University was held from 18<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> October, 2021 in the Vidyapati Sabhagar, Dr. Rajendra Prasad Central Agricultural University, Pusa. The three-days event was inaugurated by Hon'ble Vice Chancellor. Eminent Scientist's Dr. A. K. Sharma ex-Director, National Bureau of Agriculturally Important Microorganisms, Mau (UP) graced the occasion as invited scientific guest. Release of Books/Bulletins was done by the dignitaries. Presently, 82 university funded projects of worth Rs 4 crores, is running in the university. Seven externally funded project (two from IRRI, Mokama Ghat project, one from Helipage India, one from National Bee Board Project), 33 AICRP, 05 centers of excellence, 03 foreign aided projects, 01 DST project and 01 consultancy projects are operational in the University. During the event 11 new research proposals were presented in the house for approval. The proposal for release of three new varieties viz., 2 sugarcane (one early & one late variety) and pointed guard varieties along with five new technologies.
- **Crop cutting performed in Hybrid Seed Production Project**  
Crop Cutting has been performed under "Farmers Participatory Hybrid Paddy Seed Production & Evaluation Programme" at TCA, Dholi farm on 29<sup>th</sup> October, 2021. The estimated yield of Hybrid Paddy RRH-1 and RRH-2 genotypes were found to be 27.16 and 25.00 quintals/ hectares, respectively at 12% moisture level. On this occasion, TCA, Dholi and Associate Director of Research were present along with other associated scientists, DAO, Muzaffarpur and farmers.
- **Technology Released in 11<sup>th</sup> Research Council Meeting** A hand tool for Okra harvesting was released by RPCAU, Pusa at the 11<sup>th</sup> Research Council Meeting. The technology was designed and developed at CAE, having specific features - ease of operation, minimum hand injuries and increasing the shelf life of the harvested Okra. Capacity and cost of the tool are 13.64 kg/h and Rs.200/- respectively.





- **Inauguration of Freshwater Giant Prawn Hatchery:** Dr. L. Murugan, Hon'ble Minister of State of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Govt. of India inaugurated Freshwater Giant Prawn Hatchery at COF, Dholi through virtual mode on 24<sup>th</sup> October, 2021.
- **Dr. (Smt.) Suvarna Chandrappagari, IFS, Chief Executive, NFDB, Hyderabad** visited College of Fisheries, Dholi on 26<sup>th</sup> October, 2021 to review different ongoing projects of NFDB at COF, Dholi.



- **Sri Mukesh Sahani, Hon'ble Minister of Animal and Fisheries Resource Department, Govt. of Bihar** inaugurated NFDB Sponsored River Ranching Programme on 27<sup>th</sup> October 2021 at Ranighat, Patna. Two lakh fish seed were released in each of three rivers, The Ganga, Gandak and Budhi Gandak under River Ranching Programme.



## Extension Activities

- **The KVK, Birauli, Samastipur** has emerged on potato seed production during Rabi 2020-21 to contribute in the endeavor of RPCAU, Pusa to meet the quality potato seed demand of farmers. The center has produced 105 q of quality seed of Kufri Mohan variety. To strengthening the linkage with KVKs of the university and institute, the seed are supplied to ICAR-KVK, Buxar (30 q), KVK, Gaya, BAU, Sabour (30 q), KVK, Piprakothi, RPCAU, Pusa (10 q), KVK, Madhepura, BAU, Sabour (24 q). The seed supplied are mainly utilized under CRA programme, seed production programme and FLDs by the KVKs.



- **The 14<sup>th</sup> Scientific Advisory Committee (SAC) meeting** for the year 2020-21 has been conducted on 22.10.2021 presided by Dr. M.S. Kundu, Director, Extension Education, RPCAU, Pusa. The mandatory progress report was presented and action plan for the



year 2021-22 has been finalized with due deliberation. The meeting had been participated by Dy. Director, Extension Education.

- **One day training programme on Soil Health Management** was organised at TCA, Dholi on 21.10.2021 in association with 40 farmers from PRAYATNA, NGO, Muzaffarpur. The training was inaugurated by Dean, TCA, Dholi.



- **Integrated Nutrient Management Training to Fertilizer Dealers:** As envisaged by Govt. of India, KVK, Birauli has organized 15 days residential training programme for fertilizer dealers of Samastipur district, during 16.10.2021 to 30.10.2021.

- **Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Parsauni** got inaugurated the Establishment of

Nutrition garden at Mahatma Gandhi Central University, Motihari at Main campus under the technical guidance of KVK, Parsauni, East Champaran-II by Hon'ble Vice Chancellor Prof. Sanjeev Kumar Sharma of the MG Central University in the presence of senior officers of the University and Senior Scientist and Head, KVK, Parsauni, East Champaran-II.

- **Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Turki** organized World Food Day programmes under Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav on 16.10.2021 at KVK Turki under the Chairmanship of Dr. A.K. Singh Dean, TCA, Dholi. Detailed discussion were held on food security for children and growing bio-fortified variety and major role of millet in our food, seasonal vegetable, and pulses. In this programme 57 farmers and farmwomen participated.

- **Skill development training programme on "Farm machinery Services and Maintenance Technician"**



Valedictory function of the 26-day training program on "Services and Maintenance Technician –Farm Machinery" was organised on 25<sup>th</sup> October, 2021 in the presence of Dr Ambrish Kumar, Dean, CAE, Dr. S. K. Patel, HOD, FMPE, District Agriculture Officer, Samastipur, Faculties and staff of Department of Farm Machinery and Power Engineering, CAE. Nine such Training programs



have been awarded to the college by the Bihar government, aiming to gear up farm mechanization in Bihar. Field demonstration of Super seeder was conducted on 31<sup>st</sup> October, 2021 by Dr. S. K. Patel, HoD, FMPE. Super seeder is a combination of rotary tiller and planter with press wheels, useful for removing stubble and roots of paddy, sugarcane, cotton, banana, maize etc.

- **Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Turki** organized Kisan Chaupal cum training on 25.10.2021 at Sakra block Rabi crop production technology in Chairmanship of Project Director ATMA, Muzaffarpur and Panchayat Mukhiya Sh. Ramanand Prasad Sakra block. In this event 233 farmers and farm women participated. Sr. Scientist and KVK Turki delivered lecture on organic farming practices under climate resilient programmes.



- **Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Saran** conducted On Farm Testing (OFT) on Horticulture entitled Regulation of bearing potential in litchi (*Litchichinensis*) through girdling of primary branches in Saran district of Bihar started in 7 location in Saran district.

- **Krishi Vigya Kendra, Narkatiaganj** demonstrated innovative Sugarcane settling transplanting technique (STT) for improved high yielding varieties. Single bud settling transplanting, spaced transplanting (STP) and polybag nursery are some of the options available for reducing the seed requirement in sugarcane crop. KVK organized a training and method demonstration program on sugarcane STT. In this event 30 farmers participated were provided with about 40000 seedlings (Rajendra ganna-1) developed by KVK for quality seed production.
