The first initiative marked the commencement of the 15th Research Council meeting Rabi 2023-24, where release proposals of two varieties namely Hydride Shaktiman 6 of Maize and Rajendra Suflam of Mustard was recommended by the house for release and notification from SVRC/CVRC. In addition to these two recommended varieties one innovative technology "Mushroom Badi Production Technology" was also released by research council.

In the series of commitment of advance capacity building initiative, the university organised a Short Course on 'Crop Diversification and Utilization of Crop Waste to Achieve Climate-Resilient Agriculture and Improvement in Farmers' Income in Fragile Agri-Ecosystem. 'This program aimed to equip participants with knowledge and strategies for sustainable agriculture in challenging environments.

Furthermore, a 21-day Winter School on 'Epigenetic Regulations as Drivers of Insecticide Resistance and Resilience to Climate Change in Agricultural Pests' was initiated. This training focused on advancing studies related to insecticide resistance and their effective management, contributing to the overall resilience of agricultural ecosystems.

Further aligning with the new education policy 2020, aiming at empowering minds, transforming futures, developing innovation, shaping leaders and build a nation of lifelong learners, our university marked a significant milestone with the second batch of our flagship programme Diksharambh to newly admitted students. New Batch of 553 Students Admitted to RPCAU, Pusa

In a significant development, Rajendra Prasad Central Agricultural University (RPCAU) at Pusa has welcomed a fresh cohort of 553 students across undergraduate (UG), postgraduate (PG), and PhD courses. This diverse intake reflects the university's commitment to academic excellence and inclusivity.

Among the admitted students, a notable 238 are female, marking a positive stride towards gender parity and empowerment in agricultural education. This surge in female enrollment underscores RPCAU's dedication to fostering a conducive learning environment for all aspiring scholars.

RESEARCH ACTIVITIES

The 15th Research Council Meet (Rabi: 2023-24) was organized by the Directorate of Research from 15th to 17th January 2024. The event was inaugurated by Dr. P. S. Pandey, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, RPCAU, Pusa. The event was graced by the presence of Dr. A.R. Pathak, Former Vice Chancellor, Navsari Agriculture University, Gujarat and Dr. Bikas Das, Director, ICAR-NRC Litchi, Muzaffarpur, Bihar as member of the Research Council of RPCAU, Pusa. During the meeting fifteen (15) university funded, ten (10) externally funded, twenty-one (21) ICAR-AICRPs and thirty-nine (39) new proposals of university funded projects were presented by the respective Principal Investigator. Each presentation prompted thorough discussions on the ongoing and future research endeavours within the university.



During this event the release proposal for two varieties namely Hybrid Shaktiman-6 (QPMMH 27) of Maize and Rajendra Suflam-1 (RAURD 18-1) of Mustard was recommended by the house for release and notification from SVRC/CVRC as well as one technology "Mushroom Badi Production Technology" were presented and after the discussion the technology was released by the research council.



Participation in the XI Group Meet of ICAR-AICRP on Fruits at NAU, Navsari (Gujrat) Dr. S. K. Singh, Prof. Plant Pathology & Principal Investigator along with the associated scientist Dr Asish Panda Asstt. Prof. Horticulture from RPCAU, Pusa participated in the XI Group Meet of ICAR-AICRP on Fruits held at NAU, Navsari (Gujrat) from 22nd to 25th January 2024. All the ongoing experiments and new trials were elaborately discussed during the event. Two new banana varieties, first namely Kaveri Kanchan (Nendran × Culcutta-4), a dual purpose banana with better chips making and dessert quality and second namely Kaveri Vamana (a gamma mutant of Grand Naine), an ultra dwarf banana for wind prone areas and terrace garden were recommended for growing in Bihar.

Total 81 pilots have been trained so far from the RPTO, CAET, RPCAU, Pusa. Out of 81, 35 women are trained, named as Drone Didi under the Namo Drone Didi scheme of the Govt of India.
