> Approaching carbon free villages in Samastipur (Bihar): Dean, CAET visited villages on 31st March 24 - Chakhaji, Chandauli and Morsand which are equipped with around thirty 5hp solar pumps and irrigating their entire Agri fields by underground pipeline system and collapsible pipes. Farmers of these villages are applying green energy in irrigation and made their villages carbon free, particularly in irrigation. They earn around Rs 50000 per year by selling irrigation water to other farmers. Farmers gave their feedback with higher preference for solar pump over electric power operated pumps.



## **EXTENSION ACTIVITIES**

> KVK, Turki, RPCAU, Pusa organized Kisan Mela on 18.03.2024. Dr. P.S. Pandey Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, RPCAU Pusa, graced the occasion with Dr. MS Kundu, Director, Extension Education, Dr. PP Srivastava, Dean, COF, Dholi, Dr. Maynk Rai, Dean, PGCA, Pusa, Dr. Ambrish Kumar, Dean, CAET, Pusa and Dr. K. Kumar Dean PDUCHF, Piprakothi. Among all, 3064 women from all blocks of Muzaffarpur district were participated in the Kisan mela. Hon'ble Vice Chancellor highlighted about the major role played by the women farmer in Bihar agriculture development and adoption of new technologies and distributed Best Progresive farmers' awards to farmers and farm women. Similarly, KVK Turki also conducted farmers' field visit, diagnostic services, and farmers' scientist interaction on 14.03.2024 at Karanpur village. In this event 45 farmers participated.

The rural young women of Bihar are ranked 33rd among the total 36 states and union territories of India in terms of digital skill. Total 36 farm women received off-campus as well as training in the computer lab of the CCS.



**CBS&H, RPCAU, Pusa organized a one-day Visit** of school students on 20.03.2024 under the Social Scientific Responsibility (SSR) activity of the SERB-Funded project. The Programme is being organized under PM SHRI Internship Development Programme of Government of India on NEP-2020 framework and a MoU has been signed between RPCAU, and PM SHRI JNV Birauli for the implementation of the programme. Although 350 students will be trained under this initiative and in first phase 80 students are undergoing the training. The students are provided multidisciplinary exposure to various techniques and given knowledge about entrepreneurial development through skill development under each module. The training programme will help in motivating, attracting and re-orienting the young students towards bio-entrepreneurship.
