EDUCATION & EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITIES

> Students of Jawahar Navodaya Vidayalaya, Birauli, Samastipur visited CoF, Dholi on 4-5 April, 2024. During their visit, they were exposed to various advanced techniques in Aquaculture, including Hi-tech Aquaculture, Recirculatory Aquaculture System (RAS), Biofloc technology, Pond preparation and Ornamental fish culture.



The University organized two days National Workshop on "Natural Farming and its Scope Under Changing Climatic Scenario" to get familiar with the ideas and aspects of natural farming, farm design, agroecological practices, standards and certification, marketing, natural resource value with enhanced human resource competency in soil health restoration, biodiversity conservation, animal welfare, effective use of natural/local resources, ecological fairness and balance during 20-21, April, 2024.

The workshop was graced by Hon'ble Governor of Bihar, Shri Rajendra Viswanath Arlekar Ji as Chief Guest. He inaugurated the newly developed Samvidhan Park of the university, B.Sc. (Hon.) Natural Farming degree programme, released the booklet "School of Natural Farming: At a Glance" and launched Rajendra Honey Blister during the occasion. Vice – Chancellors of four Agricultural Universities had graced the occasion. Altogether 379 participants including eminent



experts, Scientists, Natural Farming Practitioner, farmers and students from different corners of country were the participants. Hon'ble Vice- Chancellor, Dr. P. S. Pandey felicitated 30 Natural Farming Practitioner during valedictory function.



Post Graduate College of Agriculture: PGCA successfully organized PG Students Conclave on 28th April 2024. The conclave was graced by Dr. N.S. Rathore, Former Vice-Chancellor of MPUAT Udaipur and Former DDG Agricultural Education at ICAR, as the Chief Guest. The inaugural session was chaired by Dr. P.S. Pandey, Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor of RPCAU. Addressing the gathering of 173 PG and Ph.D. students from RPCAU as well as students from Central Agricultural University, Imphal and Rani Laxmi Bai Central Agricultural University, Jhansi, faculty, and officials. Dr. Rathore emphasized the applications of digital tools in agriculture and urged students to focus on meaningful research relevant to solving agricultural problems. Dr. Pandey highlighted that students are the backbone of any university, and their quality research is crucial for addressing challenges in agriculture. He announced that the PG-Conclave will be an annual event at RPCAU. Other dignitaries Dr. Mayank Rai, Dean PGCA, Dr. A.K. Singh, DR, RPCAU, and Dr. U.K. Behera, DoE, RPCAU also participated in the conclave. During the occasion, RPCAU Journal of Student Research Abstract (Volume 1) prepared by Dr. Usha Singh, Dr. K.L. Bhutia and Dr. Sangita Sahni containing the compiled abstracts of the PG and Ph.D. thesis submitted during 2023 was also inaugurated.



First semester students of TCA, Dholi visited Biodiversity Park, Pusa for practical class (Agroforestry) on 25th April 2024. Students learnt about different plant species and their economical, medicinal and spiritual importance.




➤ Dr. Ambrish Kumar, Dean, CAET and Chairman of School Management Committee attended annual function of Rajendra Shishu Sadan organised in Vidyapati Sabhagar, RPCAU, Pusa on 3rd April 2024. The school was established in 1972 just after foundation of university in 1970. Dr. P.S. Pandey, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, RPCAU was the chief guest of the function. The school has been upgraded up to middle school, students' strength increased from 350 (2021) to 548 (2024); school dropout is <0.5% and its deposits has increased upto > Rs 2 crore. School is transforming itself in the framework of NEP-2020.



An online webinar by CCS-NIAM, Jaipur was conducted on 'Innovation, Entrepreneurship and venture development' on 1st of April, 2024. Mr. Akshay Patidar, Assistant Professor, CCS-NIAM emphasized on importance of green packing solutions in supply chain. Also an online webinar on Starting the Agri- startups (Growth Strategies: Lessons from Mithila Naturals) was conducted by startup cell AIIC, RPCAU, Pusa on 4 April, 2024. Mr. Manish Anand, CEO and

RESEARCH ACTIVITIES

Scientist delivered lecture as a resource person for FAO: Dr. S P Singh, Associate Professor (Soil Science) delivered a lecture as resource person in the webinar on 'Crop Nutrition in Salt Affected Soil' organized by Food and Agriculture Organizations (FAO) and the International Networks of Salt-Affected Soils on April 24 2024. He also participated as panelist in the panel discussion of the same event.



New Automatic Weather Station installed: A new Automatic Weather Station has been installed in the agrometeorological observatory of RPCAU, Pusa. This will help in precise recording of weather data and advancement in climate research.



EXTENSION ACTIVITIES

Sowing of green gram has completed at adopted villages of CRA programme. A part from this regular field visits all being conducted to inspect the status of green gram germination with advisories to the farmers. Four training programmes; one field day and wheat crop cutting programmes were also held to train 170 farmers. Under these training

programmes package of practices of green gram cultivation, importance of laser land levelling and importance of millets has been discussed with the farmers.



▶ KVK, Madhopur started a poultry hatchery unit: KVK, Madhopur established a hatchery unit to produce layer chicks, ducklings, and quail chicks to meet the demands of backyard poultry farming in rural areas of West Champaran. The unit is being operated with 3 machine having capacity of 300 eggs production and fertilized eggs of ducks, Vanraja chicks, and quail eggs with total hatching rate of 80%. After hatching the duckling and chicks were kept in duckery and poultry unit for further rearing. KVK, Madhopur in the future shall be able to supply the chicks and ducklings to small-scale poultry farmers or backyard poultry farmers for producing egg and meat.




Programmes; one field day and wheat crop cutting programmes with the participation of 170 farmers at villages under CRA programme. Under these training programmes package of practices of green gram cultivation, importance of laser land leveling and importance of millets has been discussed with the farmers. They also organized training programme on Beekeeping (8-10th April 2024), Kuroiler production (25th April 2024) and distributed Kuroiler to 37 farmers, 1000 papaya seedlings to 25 farmers and flour making machines to 8 farmers from SC community under SCSP programme.
