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
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FROM THE DESK OF VICE-CHANCELLOR

In continuation of our efforts to integrate traditional knowledge with modern research, in collaboration with the Indian Agro Economic Research Centre, New Delhi, University hosted a two-day national workshop on "Traditional Knowledge and Modern Perspectives in Indian Agriculture Amidst Climate Change" from 8th to 9th June 2024 facilitating exchange ideas of 100 delegates, including scientists, farmers, and students.

We also organized 16th RCM Special session from 10-11 June-2024 in the presence of domains expert like Dr. Naresh Chandra, Principal Scientist, Agricultural Economics, ICAR-RCER, Patna; Dr. S.K. Chaturvedi, Director Research, RLBCAU, Jhansi and Dr. N.R. Gangadharappa, Former Director Research, UAS, Banglore, who reviewed the 59 research proposals submitted by the University Faculty Members.

As one of the important initiatives of digital learning and scientific communication the university organized a workshop P. 5 on the implementation and development of SWAYAM MOOCs and blended learning on 12th June, enhancing digital learning and providing flexible, accessible education to a wider audience. Two learned guest speakers for the programme were Dr. G.R. Ramakrishna Murthy from NAARM, Hyderabad, and Mr. Shib Shankar Das from IIT Kharagpur. Similarly, a sensitization workshop on "Writing and Citing Good Scientific Papers' was also organized on 20th June 2024 for enhancing the scientific writing skills of our researchers, emphasizing the importance of proper citation and techniques for writing impactful scientific papers. Dr. Aruna T. Kumar, Former Chief Editor, DKMA, ICAR; Dr. Sridhar Gutam, Principal Scientist, ICAR-IIHR, Banglore; and Dr. G. Ratna Sabhapati, University Librarian, TANUVAS, Chennai delivered insightful talks and shared essential elements of high impact scientific research articles writing.

International Yoga Day was celebrated on 21st June with the help of the Art of Living Foundation on the theme "Yoga for Self and Society," saw enthusiastic participation of officers, teachers, students, and staff, highlighting the holistic benefits of yoga for physical and mental well-being.

➤ Vertical farming system installed under PFDC Project Under the Precision Farming Development Centre (PFDC), College of Agricultural Engineering and



Technology, various types of frames were installed in a greenhouse to demonstrate advanced agricultural technologies, *viz.* hydroponic and aeroponic as the vertical agriculture. Such agriculture is becoming popular as an urban farming system for daily growing

green/ leafy vegetables in balcony/roof terrace. This project is funded by the National Committee on Precision Agriculture and Horticulture (NCPAH), MoA&FW, GoI. Short-term training programs were also organized by PFDC for progressive farmers on various topics associated with precession farming.

Digital Agriculture–Agri-IoT Device installed Jiokrishi Agri IoT device equipped with sensors viz. soil moisture, soil/air temperature, RH, leaf area index, and rain gauge was installed. A cluster of 5 villages, including Kothiya, in the range of 2 km radius is covered under the system. 100 farmers in these 5 villages are connected with the system, and they get agricultural advisory services through the Jiokrishi app. This setup is installed under PFDC project (CAET, Pusa) funded by NCPAH, MoA&FW, GoI.

Post Graduate College of Agriculture: The Department of Extension Education organized a 3-day national-level training (virtual mode) on the topic "Gender Mainstreaming in Agriculture" (10-12th June 2024) in collaboration with the National Institute of Agricultural Extension Management (MANAGE), Hyderabad in which a total of 190 participants have participated.
