

#### **EDUCATION & EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITIES**

> Students of TCA, Dholi (Batch- 2020-24) achieved good ranks in ICAR-AIEEA (PG) 2024 and 19 students were finally selected. Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor Dr. P.S. Seven B.Tech. Agricultural Engineering students were recruited by TAFE with a package of 6 lakh per annum. On 22.09.2024 thirteen shortlisted students (based on online examination) were interviewed by TAFE officials out of whom seven were finally selected.

#### RESEARCH ACTIVITIES

women An Awareness programme on 'Importance of Balanced diet for Healthy Family' was conducted by Department of Food Science and Nutrition, College of Community Science, Pusa, for farm women on 10.9.2024 at village Ladaura, Kalyanpur block, Samastipur district during the Rastriya Poshan Maah, 2024. This programme was aimed for creating awareness among farm women about balanced diet and to ensure adequate and appropriate diets for healthy lifestyle to prevent different non-

communicable diseases like obesity, diabetes, hypertension. etc. More than 100 farm women participated in the event.



This programme was aimed for creating awareness among farm women, adoption of appropriate pre-cooking and different processing methods for millets and their value-added products. This programme was attended by more than 35 farm women and girls.



➤ The monitoring team visited Experimental Fields Scientific monitoring team of ICRISAT visited and reviewed the CoEMVC project running at RPCAU on 24th September 2024. All the

Maize: ICAR-IIMR Monitoring team visited the experimental field of AICRP on Kharif Maize, TCA, Dholi Centre on 29.09.2024. Members of the monitoring team critically observed the field experiments of Breeding, Agronomy, Pathology and Entomology and also discussed the FLD programme. All the associated scientists and staff were present during the visit.



Millets: The monitoring team of ICAR-AICRP on Small Millets visited the experimental plots of RPCAU Small Millets at Dholi and Pusa on 30.09.2024. All the scientists and research scholars associated with the project were present.



Fraining Program organized for the Bee Keepers Six days training programme was organized from the 6 to 11 September, 2024 on topic 'Strengthening scientific beekeeping enterprises and value addition of honey'. Fifty farmers/ beekeepers from different districts of Bihar participated in the training programme. The programme was under the project 'Prospering Litchi Honey Development through Geographic Indicators in Bihar' funded by National Bee Board at Beekeeping Centre, RPCAU, Pusa.

This display was part of a one-day national conference focused on "Climate Friendly Agriculture and Disaster Management for a Prosperous Nation.



➤ Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Jale organized awareness cum interaction program on Climate Resilient Agriculture on 23rd September 2024.

# TRAINING/WORKSHOP/SEMINAR/ AWARENESS PROGRAMMES ORGANIZED

Firshi Vigyan Kendra, Vaishali organized a five days training program on Mushroom production from 19<sup>th</sup> to 23<sup>rd</sup> September, 2024 wherein 30 participants were participated. Similarly, Poshan Maah was celebrated from 1<sup>st</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup> September 2024. During this month-long event, various competitions and programmes were conducted on role of nutrition & dietary practices. An awareness on Nutri Garden and Biofortified

varieties was also organized and provided to the farmers and farm women.



Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Parsauni organized one day off campus training program on "Importance of Micro Irrigation System in Agriculture" on 13.09.2024 at Noniya (KachariTola), Paharpur where 29 farmers participated in the training program. KVK Parsauni celebrated Technology Week from September 23rd to 28th 2024, focusing on themes such as innovative agricultural practices. Farmers had the opportunity to explore various demonstration units, including Azolla, the farm implement bank, vermicomposting, solar trees, integrated farming systems (IFS), DSR, millets and KVK's vegetable nursery. Five days (15th to 20th September 2024) vocational training program was also organized for rural youth on topic entitled "Solar Powered Irrigation System" at KVK Campus.



Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Gopalganj in September 2024, KVK Gopalgani conducted 09 trainings for practicing farmers and 02 for rural youth. These trainings collectively reached a total of 213 participants. Farmers were acquainted with the importance of using improved threshing implements, resource conservation technologies for sustainable production of cereal crops, nutri garden (Poshan Mah), value addition of seasonal vegetables and fruits (Poshan Mah), pest management in paddy crop, crop diversification and its role in climate change, and importance of scientific cultivation of different types of mushrooms. Under the Climate Resilient Agriculture Programme (CRAP), 03 trainings programmes have been conducted on importance of short duration varieties and micro irrigation techniques in mitigating draught conditions. A total of 75 farmers participated in these training programmes. Technology week and Swachhta Abhiyan have also been celebrated at KVK Gopalganj by organizing different training programs, awareness programmes and tree plantation.



➤ Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Saraiya organized five days on Campus vocational training on "Goat Production" and "Seed production" from 10th to 18th September 2024, where in 44 and 53 participants participated, respectively. Likewise, five day on campus vocational training on "Care and

maintenance of agricultural machinery and solar power irrigation systems" and "Fish Polyculture in Pond" were organized from 20th to 25th September 2024 where in 27 and 37 participants participated.
