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
FROM THE DESK OF VICE-CHANCELLOR

> "3rd Deeksharambh: Empowering Future Leaders - University Foundation Course (2024)"

Dr. Rajendra Prasad Central Agricultural University launched the third edition of its unique concept induction programme, "Deeksharambh," on 18th October 2024 for newly admitted undergraduate students. This programme, now part of the UGC curriculum, aims to holistic development and empower students to face the challenges of an everchanging world with the new environment from school to college and the university education system.

The inauguration was chaired by Dr. P.S. Pandey, Vice Chancellor of RPCAU, with Shri Sudhanshu Ranjan, Ex-ADG of Doordarshan and Akashwani, as the Chief Guest. The 15-days long induction programme helped students in keeping healthy mind and body hence this programme was structured with diverse activities like—Yoga, Games & Sports, Art & Craft, Dance & Music, Drama & Theatre, Soft Skill Development, Cultural and Literary events etc with a focus on practical learning, including visits to Krishi Vigyan Kendras (KVKs) to explore agricultural applications.



Eminent guests like by Shri Abhayananda, founder of Super-30, Motivational speakers Shri

Shashikant Rai, and officials like Shri Ashok Kumar Mishra (SP, Samastipur) and Mr. Sanjay Kumar Singh (Lead Consultant, Dimensions Education) graced the programme and inspired the students with potential to face and resolve the challenges of life from time to time with utmost grace and perseverance.



The auspicious event was the "Deepotsav" on the eve of Diwali festival, where approx. 50K diyas were lit, creating a spectacular visual moment. The Heartfulness meditation session was conducted by Dr. Nivedita Shreyansh, and a cyber-awareness programme was led by Dr. Neeti Goel, a cyberbullying expert.

The successful journey of 3rd Deeksharambh-2024 concluded with the "Pradakshina" valedictory function on 1st November 2024, graced by Dr. R.C. Agarwal, DDG (Education) at ICAR, New Delhi. RESEARCH ACTIVITIES

> RPCAU participated in the National Consultation on Food System for Systainability and Profitability of millets from 5th to 6th October, 2024 at RLBCAU, Jhansi. The key research accomplishments and ongoing research on millet in RPCAU were exhibited during the programme.



> Two Maize varieties Rajendra Pop Corn-1 & Rajendra Baby Corn-1 of RPCAU, Pusa was notified by Gazette, Government of India.

Scientist from ICAR-National Research Centre on Banana, Tiruchirapalli visited RPCAU, Pusa Dr. A. Mohanasundaram, Senior Scientist (Entomology) from ICAR-NRCB, Tiruchirapalli visited RPCAU from 2nd to 8th October 2024. During this visit, he monitored the ongoing trials of bananas under the ICAR-AICRP on Fruits project. All the scientists and staffs associated with ICAR-AICRP on Fruits were present. The ongoing research activity and scope of collaboration between RPCAU, Pusa and ICAR-NRCB, Trichy were discussed.



> Explorative Survey conducted in the Banana growing belts of Muzaffarpur and Vaishali District An exploratory survey was conducted in the

traditional banana growing belts of Muzaffarpur and Vaishali District on 24th October, 2024 by the scientific team of RPCAU Pusa working on Banana. The long-term banana-based farming system in the Hajipur area were explored. The team identified and collected one unique landrace each of Chinia and Malbhog bananas.



Millets-based value-added products developed from RPCAU Pusa, were launched by FPO-Poshan Aahaar at Knowledge Centre, Gangapur, Bihar on 29th October 2024. The scientists associated with Centre of Excellence on Millets, ICAR-AICRP on Women in Agriculture were present during the event.



EXTENSION ACTIVITIES

> KVK Madhopur organized an Animal Health camp Animal Health camp under the TDC, NICRA- SCSP Project on 24th October 2024, in collaboration with the Department of Animal Husbandry, Government of Bihar at Parsa village, of Manjhaliya Parkahand. Farmers were briefed about

animal stress due to climatic factors and diseases. Experts guided the dairy farmers on shelter management, clean milk production, reproduction management, supplementary feed and fodder management. A total of 138 animals, including cows, buffaloes, and goats, were treated during the camp. Additionally, mineral mixtures, deworming tablets, and other essential veterinary medicines were distributed to the beneficiaries..



KVK Vaishali in collaboration with Green TV India organized a "Kisan Chaupal" on 24th October 2024 focusing on Chilli Cultivation and Scientific Seed Development of Vegetable Crops. A total of 235 Farmers participated in the Kisan Chaupal where various technical sessions such as: importance of soil testing and nutrients fertilizers management in vegetable crop, Modern agriculture technology & important government schemes, Importance of value addition in Chilli crop, Package and practices of major vegetable crop, etc. were conducted by KVK scientists. During the event, progressive farmers were felicitated for their contributions and innovative approaches to farming practices. Additionally, a 3-day Demonstration cum Hands-on Training Program entitled "Protected

Cultivation of Exotic Fruit Crops" was conducted from 26th to 28th October 2024 for rural youth and women. After successful completion of the training program, certificates were distributed to 35 trainees. In the same month, under the ARYA Project, KVK Vaishali distributed planting materials of exotic varieties of capsicum, cauliflower, broccoli, tomato, and brinjal to farmers to promote advanced cultivation practices.



TRAINING/WORKSHOP/SEMINAR/ AWARENESS PROGRAMMES ORGANIZED

➤ KVK Turki have organized one day awareness cum training programme on "Importance of agridrone in agriculture and integrated crop management practices and a one day awareness cum kisangosthi on "organic seed production and vermin-composting" on 21st and 22nd October 2024, respectively. Likewise, they also conducted field visit cum practicing farmers training on IMP in brinjal.



Others events were also conducted like scientific goat farmers training, oilseed production technology, and demonstration on mustard seed variety Rajendra Suflam at KVK adopted villages on 17.10.2024 at Aurai block.

Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Sheohar: KVK Sheohar in collaboration with the District Horticulture Department, conducted two training programs on mushroom production and beekeeping on 18th to 19th October and 22nd to 24th October 2024, respectively. Both the training programmes were designed to enhance the local agricultural practices and promote sustainable livelihoods in the region. Cluster frontline demonstrations (CFLDs) on rapeseed (Rajendra Suflam-1) were started by KVK Sheohar by imparting training to 500 farmers and distributed critical inputs to enhance crop production and improve farming techniques. They also initiated climate-resilient program for Rabi 2025 in five adopted villages, initiating line sowing of lentils to promote sustainable agricultural practices.



> KVK Saraiya organized training programme on "Scientific cultivation of Mustard" under Cluster Frontline Demonstration (CFLD) on oilseed on 08th October 2024 where the SMS (Crop Production) deliberated on agronomic practices,

weed, pests and disease management. Following the session, critical inputs were provided to the participants. A total of 70 farmers participated. Demonstration on line sowing of Rapeseed and mustard (Var. R. Suflam) was carried out at Dwarikanathpur village under CRA Programme on 24th October, 2024. A vocational training program on "Goat Production" was conducted for rural youth from October 25 to 30, 2024, with a total of 42 participants. Similarly, on 30th October 2024, a field day and crop cutting under the Climate Resilient Agriculture (CRA) Programme for yield estimation of the paddy crop were carried out at Dwarikanathpur village, in the presence of district line department officials.
